POLICY: The Tangerine Avenue driveway gate shall be closed, but **not** locked, whenever the church facilities are not in use.

Development: The development of this P&P shall involve the collaboration of the Church President, Pastor, one or two representatives from the Community Concerns Board and one or two representatives from the Property Board.

Procedures: The following procedures are to be followed regarding the Tangerine driveway gate.

- 1. The first person using the church facilities, each day, is to open the gate; the last person using the church facility is to close the gate but **not** lock the gate.
- 2. The gate is to be left open when the facilities are in use.
- 3. If a church member finds the gate open, when it is known that the gate should be closed, the member should close the gate but **not** lock the gate.
- 4. If a church member discovers unknown individuals or vehicles within the church facilities and it cannot be **safely** determined that the situation is acceptable, the person should notify the City of Sacramento police.
- 5. As used in this document, a person means any church member, part-time or full-time user of the facilities, visitor, etc.

Notifications: The congregation members, facility users, and others shall be notified before new or revised operational procedures are effective for the Tangerine driveway gate. This may be accomplished through the *News & Views*, e-mails, Sunday announcements, etc.

Review: This P&P is to be reviewed at least annually. Reviews are to follow the collaboration guidelines under "Development", above.
