





Property Board News

Property Board Drainage Fee:

The Property Board has been in contact with the city utilities department regarding the application of the new 2022 drainage fee. After several months of contact, St. Luke's received a response that only addressed a change in square footage of the churches parcel size. The response did not address the church's primary request of evaluation based on runoff generated using runoff coefficients for vacant and developed land. This has resulted in St. Luke's appealing the cities response. A letter requesting a hearing was submitted in writing and is awaiting the cities date for a hearing.

The church is currently billed for drainage per the 1996 and new 2022 fee structure. This results in a whopping 68% increase (\$225 monthly) for drainage. Based on our request it could lower the fee 30% (\$125 monthly) but could go lower if the request is also applied to the 1996 drainage fee.


